Q

What is KYBELLA®?

A

KYBELLA® is a prescription medicine and is the only FDA-approved injectable treatment used in adults to improve the appearance and profile of moderate to severe fat below the chin (submental fat), also called “double chin.” It is not known if KYBELLA® is safe and effective for use outside of the submental area or in children less than 18 years of age.

Q

How does KYBELLA® work?

A

The active ingredient in KYBELLA® is synthetic deoxycholic acid. Deoxycholic acid is a naturally occurring molecule in the body that aids in the breakdown and absorption of dietary fat. When injected into the fat beneath the chin, KYBELLA® destroys fat cells, and once destroyed, these cells can no longer store or accumulate fat. This results in a noticeable reduction in fullness under the chin, revealing an improved chin profile.

Q

How many treatments will I need?

A

Your specialist will create a tailored treatment plan based on your chin profile. At each treatment, you will be given multiple small injections under your chin. You may receive up to 6 treatment sessions, spaced at least 1 month apart. However, many patients experience visible results in 2 to 3 KYBELLA® treatments. 59% of patients received 6 treatments in clinical studies.

Q

What are the possible side effects?

A

The most common side effects are swelling, bruising, pain, numbness, redness and areas of hardness around the treatment area. These are not all of the possible side effects of KYBELLA®. Please call us with any questions regarding side effects.

Q

How long will results last?

A

When injected into fat under the chin, KYBELLA® causes the destruction of fat cells. Once destroyed, those cells cannot store or accumulate fat. After reaching your desired aesthetic, further treatment is not expected.

Q

How many people have been treated with KYBELLA®?

A

KYBELLA® has been the focus of a global clinical development program involving over 20 clinical studies. More than 1600 people were treated with KYBELLA® in these studies.

Q

Do I need to take time off work to recuperate?

A

NO. It is a simple procedure with a quick recovery time. Most patients feel comfortable resuming their normal activities immediately following treatment. You are free to eat, drink, or wear makeup with sun block shortly after treatment. There will likely be some temporary swelling and/or redness to the treated area, which should subside within 5 to 7 days.

Q

Does it hurt?

A

Most people report that Kybella treatments are associated with some level of discomfort. To minimize discomfort, ice packs will be applied prior to and post treatment.

Q

Who performs the cosmetic injections?

A

Our Board Certified Physician, Dr. Robert Kinsella, D.O., who has been doing injectable cosmetics for more than sixteen years!

Q

How much does a treatment cost?

A

The price is dependent on how many units are used. Most patients will need 2 units of Kybella and 2-3 treatments to achieve their desired results.
